We also want everyone to know that our new Town Hall is nearly complete. The building and surrounding areas have video surveillance equipment in place.

Please keep Neighborhood Watch informed of your issues. Our Sheriff's Department personnel and Council members get the WATCH bulletins. This helps all of us better pinpoint our problem areas, and target patrol and monitoring.

By being observant and keeping the Watch Program notified, we have been able to curtail vandal activities. There are many people who have shown that they care what happens in the Village. If

you look around, you can see noticeable efforts to improve properties and quality of life. Over 125 families receive WATCH bulletins. You are part of that caring population. We help each other by keeping our eyes open and reporting issues. The earlier we address issues, the faster we can solve them!
