I have had several calls recently about Vandalism. In several cases, police reports have been filed.

REMEMBER

We have a youth curfew in Chippewa. See below.....

Review of CURFEW ordinance # 407-91. CURFEW for youth under 18 is 11PM until 5 AM, Sunday through Thursday and Midnight through 5 AM, on Friday and Saturday. During this time, they are prohibited from sidewalks, streets, or Village property.

NOTE: additional ordinances affecting curfew control: PARKS : #356-86 (tennis courts and basketball courts, amended with #492-99) and BEACH #403-91. The BEACH is open 10AM to dark, Memorial Day through Labor Day. PARKS: (including Basketball, tennis courts) are open 8 AM to dark daily. "DARK" is defined at the time when Village streetlights come on. VIOLATION for curfew and park closing is a "**Minor Misdemeanor**". I was able to discuss this with Allan Michelson. A minor misdemeanor for a juvenile will be a fine of \$150 maximum

plus court costs, estimated to be between \$80-90. Additional infractions would be at the same rate.
